


## OVERVIEW

Beginning September 6<sup>th</sup> interlibrary loan services will be provided through a new system called Illiad. Illiad provides quick turnaround time and email updates as your interlibrary loan requests is processed and delivered to you.

## HOW IT WORKS

Once you conduct a search in the online library you may see an item on the results list that has a “Look for Full Text” link. Clicking this link may take you directly to the item if it is available in another database or you will see the option to request the item via Illiad.


