##### *Describe practicum trainee duties and responsibilities:*

All duties covered will be performed under the supervision of a licensed clinician. Interns will:

- Provide personal counseling to students as needed in support of student success.
- Provide crisis intervention (this is very common) and emergency response for students and the campus community.
- Provide referral services as needed to students, faculty and staff in need of psychological or counseling resources beyond those offered on campus. Maintain collaborative relationships with college faculty, staff, and administrators, and with community mental health agencies, and coordinate services with referral resources.
- Consult with faculty, administrators and staff and provide support for students with serious personal, family or psychological issues including but not limited to domestic violence, risk of suicide, and mental illness.
- Coach faculty and staff regarding incidents of disruptive behavior by students; collaborate with college security to provide faculty and staff training on policies and procedures to address disruptive behavior.
- Work closely with college health service faculty and staff to provide outreach to the campus community regarding the availability of college health and personal counseling services and the importance of developing healthy life styles.
- Keep up to date records and documentation on services provided in accordance with APA guidelines for standard of care.

<b>VI. TRAINING/SUPERVISION PHILOSOPHY and OBJECTIVES: A.</b> Please describe below.
Our primary mission is to provide support and enhance the learning potential of our student body. To this end, we take the mental health of our students very seriously. As a community college, many of our students work full time and take full loads. Many of them are the first in their families to be attending college. They are also likely to be of low income and identify as ethnic and racial minorities. These present a whole new set of challenges including but not limited to having no familial role models to navigate the academic environment and often times not knowing how to take care of their own mental health. Other commonly encountered issues are partner and domestic violence, addictive issues, sexual and eating disorders, psychotic processes, clinical depression, spectrum anxiety disorders and personality disorders. Our roles as clinicians are: to provide the education on achieving and maintaining mental health; to assess, diagnose and treat those with more serious mental health issues; to be the first line of contact for students who need crisis intervention. We work very closely with our faculty to identify students in need and to get them the help that they deserve.


