Attending meetings on Wednesday that include the center's business meeting and clinical training these meetings combined are 3 hrs and 15 min. (11am-2:45pm). Trainees will have 1.5 hrs group supervision on Weds. or on another day that is soon TBA. Advanced practicum students will be expected to partake in marketing duties including outreach to the community as a way to promote the center as well learn the crucial skill of marketing/networking of providing mental health services. The student will be expected to gradually carry a case load of 5 direct therapy clients per week. The advanced practicum student will contract for a 2 year training commitment with the center.
