We provide sliding scale counseling to individual adults and children, couples and families. We also provide group therapy and educational classes to the community. Our staff of 22 therapists serves between 150-200 people per week. On our staff we have Clinical Psychologists, several licensed Marriage Family Therapists, as well as interns who are working towards MFT, LCSW and Ph.D. licensure.
